The altar area now focuses on the Risen Christ with the empty cross. This cross was designed by Ron Roe, and was manufactured locally. Moving the cross and affixing it to the wall took many men and a lot of effort. The interior walls of the church were insulated,

drywalled and painted. The windows on the south wall

had been previously removed when the fellowship hall was added, which was shortly before working on the sanctuary. The statue of Jesus now hangs above the



sanctuary on the west wall. When you enter the church, you view the empty cross. As you leave, you see the reminder of the Risen Christ.

God has blessed His Church with a wonderful place to worship. As we approach Christmas, take a moment to reflect on His grace, as we soon celebrate Christ's birth to this earth.

This program has been going on since 1993 and in that time has collected and delivered over 200 million gift-filled shoeboxes to boys and girls ages 2-4, 5-9, and 10-14, never to the same place twice. For many children, this is the first gift they have ever received. The shoebox presents the opportunity for children to know they are cared about and that God loves them. What a wonderful way to show our love for them. A box was put in the Fellowship hall in the hopes of filling 11 shoeboxes. The generous members of St. Mark provided enough items that we were able to fill 23 boxes. That is double what we were hoping for. Thank you all so much for donating.


