The LCMS Specific Ministry Pastor (SMP) Program

The LCMS Specific Ministry Pastor (SMP) program was introduced to members of St Mark at an information session Jan 8. The SMP program was developed by the LCMS and Concordia Seminary to help the Synod meet the need for pastors by providing an alternative to the traditional path of study on campus at St Louis. The program exists "to form pastoral leaders in existing or planned ministry and/or mission contexts where their presence is critical to the specific ministry in which they are serving.' Participants are nominated by and supported by the congregation and the LCMS District in which they will be serving. Participants complete 4 years of study, with on-line courses and short on-campus intensive courses. They are guided through the entire program by a pastor mentor/supervisor. During the first two years the participants serve as Vicars at the sponsoring congregation. During the third year of the program participants may be declared qualified for a first call and ordination. The supporting congregation calls the Specific Ministry Pastor to serve while completing the remainder of the program.

The Board of Elders has been studying the SMP program as an alternative for St Mark and, along with the Church Council, will continue to provide regular updates.
