## From Pastor Miller

This past month I had the opportunity to be at the Northwoods National Cemetery at the wreath laying ceremony in Harshaw. I was privileged to lay several of the wreaths on the graves of veterans who have served our country. Our congregation also provided some of the food that was served at the luncheon at Rondele Ranch. It is my hope that our congregation will continue to be involved in this project. As one of the speakers said, "We are here to remember not their deaths, but their lives. Each wreath is a gift of appreciation from a grateful nation."



Our synod President, Matthew Harrison, reflected on our church's strained relationship with secular government here in the United States. Here is a quote from his recent article.

"For the church, the chief issue at stake is not the troubling rapid drift of America away from Christianity or morality. The chief issue involves government and society on all levels defining what is moral or not for the church, and particularly for churchly institutions that interface with government. The Respect for Marriage Act will invite challenges to the nonprofit status of our faithful agencies of mercy and provide impetus for continued challenges to our schools and universities. This may even affect our congregations, since all of them have nonprofit status."
