From the Pastor

I'm sure that you have noticed by now that since Easter we have added two sets of candles in the altar area. The candles had been used at St. Mark years ago. Candles have been in use by the church beginning already in the Old Testament.

Already in the book of Exodus where God instructs His people to build a tabernacle, candles or lamps are to adorn the holy place. When we light the candles, it is a signal that worship is about to begin.

The two candles on the altar itself are a signal to the worshippers that Holy Communion is going to be celebrated. Traditionally, the altar candles are not present whenever Holy Communion is not a part of the worship service.

We will begin to use acolytes as soon as we can. The children will need to be trained first, and appropriate gowns need to be assigned. We hope to have acolytes on a regular basis on Sundays beginning in the early fall.
